## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ABANDONMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY

Pursuant to Section 2.4.2(B)(1)(i) of the Land Development Regulations (LDR) of the City of Delray Beach, Florida, you are hereby notified of a privately requested abandonment of right-of-way for an approximately 2,062.5 square foot area (see area in blue on aerial map - right). The subject area, which is unimproved, is located at the western terminus of an alley between Bond Way and Witherspoon Lane. A location map is provided on this notice (opposite page).

The Planning and Zoning, acting as the Local Planning Agency, will hold a Public Hearing on the abandonment request on **July 18, 2022 at 5:01 PM**, (or as soon thereafter as may be heard), in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, 100 NW 1st Avenue, Delray Beach, Florida, for the purpose of receiving public testimony.
