NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES DIVISION HOUSING PROGRAMS

The City of Delray Beach is committed to neighborhood revitalization and improving the condition of existing housing for its residents.

Housing Rehabilitation (Forgivable Loan)

- · Addresses building and code violations, interior and exterior, electrical and plumbing
- Health and safety issues and the retrofit of special items for those with special needs
- Must be a single family or duplex residential; Excludes condos and villas
- Maximum of \$60,000 secured by agreement

Purchase Assistance (First-Time Homebuyer)

- Down-payment and closing costs assistance for the purchase/rehabilitation of a residential home within the City limits of Delray Beach
- Must have not owned a home in the past three (3) years
- Must meet lender credit standards
- Attend at least six-hour classroom/virtual homebuyer education class
- Must contribute minimum 2% of the purchase price
- Housing expenses cannot exceed 40% of gross monthly income
- Subsidy is provided in the form of a mortgage as gap financing

Rental Assistance

- Assist renter household with (1) security deposit at initial occupancy or (2) eviction prevention not to exceed 6 months' rent
- Assistance with first, last and security deposit payments (*Workforce Program ONLY)

Curb Appeal (Applies to NW and SW neighborhoods)

- Grant funding provided by the Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA)
- Addresses only exterior items including exterior painting, landscaping, driveways, ramp, minor structural and other cosmetic property improvements to a single-family or duplex
- Roof repair (non-insured properties only)
- Existing fence replacement (must be tied to structural repair)
- Grant maximum of \$15,000
- *50% match of funds required if household exceeds 140% area median income limit or if an investment property

ALL PROGRAMS REQUIRE INCOME ELIGIBILITY, ARE LIMITED TO SPECIFIC BOUNDARIES AND FUNDING AVAILABILITY.
