#### **City Commission Information Letter**

## Additional Clarity and Direction to Address Challenges Involving Transient/Short-Term Residential Occupancy Use

As discussed during last week's City Commission meeting, the City is amending the transient residential uses ordinance to address short-term vacation rentals.

As noted in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Neighborhood and Community Services Sammie Walthour, guidance to this effect involves a better ability to enforce the adverse impacts that transient residentials can have on neighborhoods throughout our community, including excessive parking and "special events". This includes multiple turnovers of tenants/guests, in violation of the City's current ordinance.

With the ordinance revisions anticipated to be offered publicly during the coming weeks, staff is also preparing to administer a selection process to secure a vendor to help the City track and monitor vacation rentals. Additionally, once the revised ordinance has been approved, a communitywide educational outreach effort will be implemented, proactively addressing questions and concerns.

### Town of Gulfstream Water Service Interlocal Agreement Renewal

The 25-year water service interlocal agreement with the Town of Gulfstream is scheduled to expire June 17, 2023. The Office of the City Manager hosted a meeting with Gulfstream's leadership earlier this week to discuss considerations for a renewal. Guidance to this effect includes a timeframe for a new pact to continue to provide up to 800,000 gallons per day of potable water to Gulfstream, including operations of applicable connection points for respective delivery.

Leadership from both municipalities agreed to finalize a new agreement for review and consideration. Direction to this effect includes a rate structure in line

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with the recently adopted water rate ordinance in Delray Beach. Recommendations are anticipated during the next few months.

# Benchmark Review and Resulting Considerations Regarding a Juneteenth Holiday Recognition

In response to recent inquiries relative to the Juneteenth federal holiday, and considerations for the City of Delray Beach to formally recognize accordingly, the Department of Human Resources was asked to perform a benchmark survey of other municipalities throughout Palm Beach County and other jurisdictions in Florida to ascertain direction offered to date.

As referenced in the attached spreadsheet summary, of the 13 Palm Beach County municipalities that responded to our inquiry, 10 have adopted Juneteenth as an official holiday. Nine of which did not reduce any of the other observed holidays to accommodate the Juneteenth recognition. One agency eliminated a personal holiday benefit to support Juneteenth as outlined.

As both the City of Delray Beach and three other municipalities in Palm Beach County have yet to recognize Juneteenth as an official holiday (two of the three, the City of Boynton Beach and the City of Palm Beach Gardens are currently considering adding Juneteenth as a paid holiday), an opportunity for City Commission review and consideration will be offered during the September 6<sup>th</sup> regular meeting.

#### **Special Event Fencing**

As parameters to support special events vary depending on the specific logistics of each activity, please be advised that direction is being offered to collaborate with leadership of the Downtown Development Authority to consider event fencing requirements. As resulting staff meetings and other tasks may support recommendations to revise existing policies and practices, resulting direction will be shared with the City Commission.

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### **Calendar of Meetings, Activities and Functions**

I wish to offer appreciation to the organizers of yesterday's Delray Chamber Education Fund Annual Breakfast, specifically, the kind words, acknowledgments, and recognition of Janet Meeks, and her contributions serving the City of Delray Beach. Subject: Update on Efforts to Address Transient Residential Uses

Mr. Manager,

The department is currently working with the City Attorney's Office to prepare an ordinance to amend section 4.3.3 of the Land Development Regulations (LDR) specific to Transient Residential Uses for City Commission consideration and approval. The revisions will expand the ability of the Code Enforcement Division to address the quality-of-life impacts that transient residential uses have on neighborhoods throughout the city. Property owners will be required to obtain a zoning certificate of use and a landlord permit from the City, a business tax receipt from Palm Beach County, and all documentation as required by the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

In addition, in the upcoming fiscal year, the department will secure the services of a company to assist in monitoring and tracking transient residential activity. We anticipate that the referenced amendments in conjunction with monitoring/tracking assistance and other proactive measures will strengthen our code compliance capabilities.

The ordinance expected to be scheduled before the City Commission in the weeks to come.
