External Community Education to Support General Obligation Bond Referendum Considerations

With the recent authorization to proceed with two general obligation bond referendums, please be advised that a robust communications plan has been developed to educate the public accordingly beginning in January 2023.

As referenced in the attached summary, direction to this effect involves social media outreach, various printed materials such as postcards and banners to be positioned throughout the community, as well as a QR Code to encourage residents and stakeholders to connect with the City's website.

Next Steps Regarding Municipal Complex Public-Private Partnership Proposal Consideration Process

In response to the direction and authorization offered during the September 19th regular meeting to have CBRE work with the City to develop a proposal solicitation process for potential public-private partnership opportunities to support development and construction of new municipal complex facilities, the Office of the City Manager hosted a meeting last week with all involved to outline a specific course of action.

As referenced in the attached summary and timeline of next steps from CBRE, the remainder of this month will be devoted primarily to site analysis activities, as well as other tasks necessary for comprehensive analysis accordingly.

Direction and guidance outlined will enable a formal City Commission workshop engagement via the January 10th session.

Analysis of Transportation Enhancement Opportunities

Consistent with guidance offered during the current fiscal-year proposed budget process, staff was able to compile data necessary to consider suitable opportunities to advance transportation outcomes for our community.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Economic Development Sara Maxfield, information to this effect involves reviewing ridership data via Tri-Rail, and other public transit organizations necessary to help the City contemplate applicable opportunities moving forward.

An opportunity for direction and guidance will become available via the November 1st Regular City Commission Meeting.

<u>Digital Signature Policy to Support Electronic Plan Review</u> <u>Process</u>

Both the Department of Development Services and Information Technology, in collaboration with the Office of the City Attorney, were recently able to present to the Office of the City Manager a recommended administrative policy necessary to support the acceptance of electronic and digital signatures as a means of authenticating documents and identifying signatories.

As noted in the attached administrative policies and procedures, authorization includes governance of permit application submissions via an electronic form which will be available via the City's website in the coming weeks.

Meanwhile, the Office of Communications is currently working to create and distribute outreach and training materials necessary to help direct a full-scale deployment of the new electronic permitting system for future applicants.

Calendar of Meetings, Activities, and Functions

An integral function of this week's Executive Leadership Team meeting involved a discussion relative to expectations for departmental budgetary management, specifically line-item administration requirements and guidance necessary to alleviate superfluous budget adjustments throughout the fiscal year. Dialogue

to this effect was also apt, considering the commitments offered during Tuesday evening's meeting relative to pending administrative policy revisions to align with the City's charter provisions concerning periodic budget adjustments and the respective role of the City Commission.

Good evening,

Since the September 19th commission meeting, I have been gathering additional data as requested. The CRA has provided historical ridership data for the program that existed within the city during 2019 and 2020 (Downtown Connect) which I have included as an attachment. I have also attached the service area maps for this service. I have included the 2018 Downtown Roundabout ridership as well as the ridership numbers provided to me for the city operated trolley.

The most recent Tri-Rail ridership numbers available are from 2019 and reflect an average number of riders getting off at the Delray Beach station totaling 13,880 on weekdays and 2,869 for Saturdays and Sundays. Total average number of riders getting on at the Delray Beach station are 822 for weekdays and 219 for Saturdays and Sundays respectively, indicating more riders travel to Delray Beach then out of Delray Beach.

This information will be further analyzed by my office and presented in a concise format for ease of understanding prior to the end of the month for distribution as you see fit. Please let me know if you have any additional questions related to the information provided.



PURPOSE

This policy authorizes the use of electronic and digital signatures as a means of authenticating documents and identifying signatories for applications made to the City as part of its electronic plan review process in accordance with Florida Statutes 668.001-668-006, 713.135 (7)(b)1, and Florida Building Code, Chapter 1 Section 107.

POLICY

The use of digital signatures is the preferred method of implementing secure electronic signatures to validate a document's integrity as well as the identity of the signatory for all drawings and technical documents that must be signed and sealed by a licensed professional. Users are encouraged to utilize the ePlans software provided on the City's website for the submission of application and construction documents. Adobe Reader and Acrobat can also be used to verify digital signatures. Licensed professionals will be responsible for verifying that their signatures adhere to the requirements of the State of Florida and are utilized in accordance with the guidelines of their respective licensing boards.

PROCEDURE

- a. Licensed professionals will select a City of Delray Beach recognized digital certificate provider located on the City website.
- b. All Permit applications shall be submitted via an electronic form available at the City's website.
- c. Digitally signed and sealed plans must be uploaded in their original digital format. Scanned or printed digitally sealed plans will not be accepted.
- d. In lieu of notarization and consistent with Florida Statute 713.135(7)(b)1, the following statement must be acknowledged:

OWNER'S ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION STATEMENT: "Under penalty of perjury, I declare that all the information contained in this building permit application is true and correct."
