Delray Beach Municipal Golf Course Public-Private Partnership Proposal Review Process

The Office of the City Manager is happy to report that the City has received six proposals from potential private partners interested in the City's redevelopment goals for the Delray Beach Municipal Golf Course. An evaluation process is underway to enable final recommendations from the City Commission.

Given the technical nature and scope of the project, CBRE will continue to work with staff during the next few weeks. Meanwhile, an evaluation committee has been appointed by the Office of the City Manager. The City Commission will be able to provide their direction during the February 7th workshop meeting.

Considerations for Federal Legislative Priorities for 2023

With the Executive Leadership Team currently working to outline funding needs and opportunities for the 2023 cycle, please be advised that coordination with the City's federal lobbyist, The Color Nine Group, is being executed to prepare recommendations for City Commission review and consideration.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Assistant City Manager Jeff Oris, guidance to this effect will involve specific funding requests that align with upcoming fiscal year budget and capital improvement programming goals and objectives. This includes activities related to utilities, public infrastructure, resiliency initiatives, and public safety.

Collaborative dialogue will be offered during the January 17th City Commission meeting, to include a formal presentation by The Color Nine Group.

Follow-Up Direction Regarding Congress Avenue Planning

There is significant progress underway to support future development opportunities along the Congress Avenue Corridor. Arrangements to host a workshop meeting to discuss recommendations (in collaboration with CBRE) will take place during the February 21st session.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Economic Development Sara Maxfield, guidance to this effect will include a review of data analytics, as well as site visits and physical assessments of present conditions. The Commission will have an opportunity to provide thoughts regarding the highest and best land-use considerations, as well as an ability to offer direction that aligns with the City's long-term goals and objectives.

Follow-Up Concerning Public Safety Community Outreach and Engagement Practices

Given recent commentary offered relative to community engagement and outreach practices as facilitated by the Delray Beach Police Department and the Delray Beach Fire Rescue Department, please be advised that leadership in both public safety departments are being asked to closely evaluate and monitor external requests for participation accordingly.

Efforts include monthly reviews of allocation of resources, with an emphasis on prioritizing public safety resources. Existing community policing functions and activities will continue as such remain a best practice for law enforcement to build positive relationships with the communities they serve.

Both departments have developed specific protocols with the goal of maintaining positive external relations on a frequent and consistent basis.

Calendar of Meetings, Activities, and Functions

I offer my well-deserved compliments and appreciation to the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Department of Public Works, and all involved in this year's tree lighting event, and associated activities. It was a truly memorable evening for residents and visitors alike.

Given the popularity of this event, and other similar events, we continue to experience an increase in vehicular traffic and related parking issues. These include cars parked on the lawns at City Hall and along nearby areas not designated for parking. Direction to execute enforcement actions, including applicable coordination and repositioning of law enforcement resources, as well as instructional signage in appropriate areas, is now being given.

Mr. Moore,

I recently spoke with Michael Willis of The Color Nine Group, the firm engaged by the City to act as our lobbyist on Federal matters. Mr. Willis expressed a desire to meet with the City Commission and City staff to gather input on the City's federal legislative priorities and key project funding needs as he prepares for the upcoming Congressional session (which will begin after newly elected members are sworn in early January). To this end, I have worked with Mr. Willis to schedule a visit in Delray Beach on Tuesday, January 17, 2023.

This date was chosen to allow Mr. Willis to meet with the City Commission during their regularly scheduled session so as to discuss the anticipated policy priorities of the President and Congress for the upcoming year, provide a status update regarding the City's outstanding Community Funding Request of \$3,452,972 for City Water and Wastewater projects which was included in the proposed FY 2022-2023 Federal Budget (which Congress has not as of the writing of this email yet approved), and to gather from the Commissioners the aforementioned input on priorities and funding needs. Mr. Willis will also have the opportunity to meet with several staff members to discuss needed projects in the City so he will better be able to inform the City of appropriate Federal funding opportunities in the upcoming year.

Please let me know if you have any further questions or informational needs related to Mr. Willis' upcoming visit.
