## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## RE: THE HAMLET CORRECTIVE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT

Pursuant to the Land Development Regulations of the City of Delray Beach, you are hereby notified that the CITY COMMISSION, will conduct a PUBLIC HEARING on MONDAY, MARCH 6, 2023 at 4:00 PM to consider Ordinance No. 05-23, a City-initiated Land Use

Map Amendment (LUMA) Open Space (OS) to Low Density (LD) and Medium Density (MD) in correction of a data conversion error for 14 parcels totaling 17.03+/-acres located along Greensward Lane within The Hamlet (map below) and fully described in Ordinance No. 05-23.

The requested amendment from OS to LD and MD for the subject properties is related to a data conversion error identified by City staff. In 2016, the City switched from AutoCAD to using Geographic Information Systems (GIS) for its mapping software; the land use designation of these parcels was inadvertently changed to OS from LD and MD. Therefore, the proposed amendment corrects the mapping error by returning the designation of the subject parcels to LD and MD. The proposed land use map is provided on the following page.
