THE AWARD

The Blue Flag is an international environmental award given to communities that fulfill several criteria including water quality, environmental information, education, safety, services, and facilities. This effort by local communities and beach operators ensures everyone can expect to visit clean and sustainably managed beaches across the United States and internationally. The Blue Flag is awarded by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE), a non-governmental, non-profit environmental organization that is represented by national organizations in each participating country. The American Shore & Beach Preservation Association (ASBPA) is the U.S. Blue Flag Program National Operator. Founded in 1926, the ASBPA is dedicated to preserving, protecting, and enhancing our coasts by merging science and public policy.

The City maintains the beach by providing a balance of services that improve the environmental health of the ecosystem while providing a safe recreational amenity for residents and visitors. Delray Beach is unique for being one of the few beaches in South Florida with a dune system that remains widely vegetated with native plant species.
