City Commission Information Letter

Reorganization to Support Business Tax Receipt and Licensing Functions and Operations

To achieve efficiencies relative to customer service and internal processes, please be advised that the Office of the City Manager recently approved a reorganization that will structure the Business Tax Receipt and Licensing (BTR) functions of the Department of Neighborhood and Community Services into an operation of the Department of Development Services.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Development Services Anthea Gianniotes, guidance to this effect will restore consistency with the City of Delray Beach Code of Ordinances, specifically aligning the BTR function with the operations of the Office of the Chief Building Official. Additionally, respective staff members will soon become empowered to input applications and renewals into the City's electronic plan review system and payment portal.

With this reorganization to become effective Monday October 2nd, leadership in both Neighborhood and Community Services and Development Services have initiated the transition, including necessary staff orientations.

Presentation and Dialogue Concerning South County Administrative Complex Redevelopment Considerations

The Office of the City Manager is pleased to report that leadership from Palm Beach County has agreed to join us during the October 10th regular meeting to share details regarding its long-term redevelopment of the South County Administrative Complex.

Dialogue to this effect will enable the City Commission to offer thoughts and observations, accordingly, including a reemphasized potential connection to the Congress Avenue Master Plan.

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Both Assistant City Manager Jeff Oris and Economic Development Manager Rob Evans will represent our organization in all prospective functions and engagements.

Follow-Up Involving School District of Palm Beach County Concerning Old Plumosa School Building

In response to concerns raised publicly during the September 5th regular meeting relative to the current state of the Old Plumosa School site, please be advised that a delegation of the City's Executive Leadership Team, including myself, as well as leadership from Parks and Recreation, Public Works, Police, Fire Rescue, and Education and Workforce Coordinator Janai Bowens, are being assembled to convene with leadership of the School District of Palm Beach County to discuss potential strategies to offer remedies.

Guidance to this effect includes potential collaborations involving public safety units from both organizations, as well as an evaluation of parcel availability for other public benefit. Dialogue to this effect will also allow City leadership insights as to any plans that the district may have relative to infrastructure improvement and/or redevelopment activity at this location.

As meetings and discussion are to take place during the next few weeks, an update will be offered publicly during a following City Commission meeting.

<u>Comprehensive Evaluation Structure to Consider Atlantic</u> Avenue Historic District

Given the recently announced direction to host community symposium engagements to evaluate the merits for an Atlantic Avenue historic district (scheduled to take place Thursday, October 26th and Friday, October 27th), please be advised that the Department of Development Services is currently developing a timeline trajectory for City Commission involvement accordingly.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Development Services Anthea Gianniotes, this symposium is being directed to

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address applicable legal and economic considerations, as well as to achieve informed input from the public regarding the prospect of creating a new district.

It is therefore anticipated that a formal consideration of a historic district designation by City Commission will take place sometime in early 2024.

Calendar of Meetings, Activities, and Functions

As I was invited to serve a speaker yesterday morning as part of an area city manager panel program sponsored by the Black Chamber of Commerce of Palm Beach County, the primary basis of my presentation involved the City of Delray Beach's efforts to advance both women and minority owned business participation in municipal contracts and related procurement processes. This included a dialogue relative to our organization's current disparity study, as well as other similar leadership outcomes I've been able to direct via previous city manager assignments.

As I will enjoy a brief annual leave Friday, September 29th, to ultimately report back to City Hall Monday, October 2nd, no information letter will be issued next week. Reporting as noted will likewise resume Friday. October 6th.

Good afternoon,

I am pleased to report permit submissions through e-Plans and the payment portal are being used at a high volume by our customers. By consolidating the Business Tax Receipt (BTR) and other licensing functions under Development Services, the department can extend this streamlining to the BTR processes guickly.

- 1. The team has started building some of the BTR and licensing functions (i.e. contractor registration) as extensions of other applications in the new program.
- Consolidating BTR review with the Zoning Certificate of Use process would offer an efficiency for the customer.
- 3. Sidewalk café permits evaluate a use regulated by Planning and Zoning that is located on City rights-of-way maintained by Public Works. By adding this permit to the e-Plans portal, we can extend the same review efficiencies to Sidewalk Café permits by forwarding the plans to both PZB and Engineering simultaneously and providing the payment portal for payment. This will also facilitate tracking the amount of square footage under either FDOT or City purview.
- 4. The Code of Ordinances currently stipulates BTR is under the purview of the Chief Building Official. When the Building Division joined the Planning Department several years ago, this function may have been inadvertently separated into different departments.

Subject: Historic Symposium

Good evening,

Following the discussion at the September 18th City Commission meeting, we are planning to hold a two-day historic preservation symposium as part of the public outreach for the Atlantic Avenue Historic District consideration. We will have expert speakers providing information on historic preservation. The panelists will discuss how historic districts can benefit communities, how they might preserve the character and charm of downtown, and the legal and financial implications of designation.

The symposium will take place on Thursday, October 26th from 3 pm to 6 pm at the Field House and include a community feedback session from 10 am to noon on Friday October 27th.

I am working with Gina Carter and Michelle Hoyland to develop the itinerary and communications plan to help encourage residents and property owners to attend so their questions and concerns can be addressed and their opinions about historic districts, whether pro or con, grounded in facts.

Michelle and I have also begun scheduling individual meetings with affected property owners to gather their input in advance of the symposium and anticipate additional meetings following the symposium to help determine next steps, including the development of incentives.
