## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Delray Beach and the Service Employees International Union Florida Public Services Union, CTW, CLC on November 16, 2021 (the "Agreement") between the City of Delray Beach (the "City") and the Service Employees International Union Florida Public Services Union, CTW, CLC (the "Union") (collectively, the "Parties") is entered into on this Agreement, 2023.

WHEREAS, the City and the Union entered into the Agreement for the purpose of promoting a harmonious relationship between the Parties and to set forth rates of pay, wages, hours of work, and other condition of employment; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023 the City Commission of the City of Delray Beach directed the City Manager to propose to the Union increasing the minimum hourly rate of pay to at least \$15.00/hour for all full-time employees represented in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this increase in pay, pay grades B03 and B04 referenced in Appendix A of the Agreement are no longer applicable; and

Whereas, pay grade B05 will now be assigned to each job classification currently listed as a B03 or B04 pay grade; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the resulting compression issues created by an increase in the minimum hourly rate, a 4% increase in salary is necessary and has been accounted for in this MOU.

In consideration of the mutual promises contained in this MOU, upon ratification and effective October 2, 2023, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. This MOU applies to full-time employees represented in the Agreement.
- 2. The minimum hourly rate of pay shall be increased to \$15.32/hour, the starting salary for Grade B05.
- 3. Appendix "A" to the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Appendix "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 4. Full-time employees who are not at the maximum salary for their pay grade will receive a 4.00% salary increase.
- 5. Except as set forth in this MOU, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
