City Commission Information Letter

April 19, 2024

Implementation of Public Works Construction Projects for the Coming Months

With numerous construction projects concurrently scheduled for implementation during the next three months, leadership of the Department of Public Works was asked to compile a summary of anticipated activity.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Public Works Missie Barletto, such generally encompasses various sidewalk, parking, pedestrian, and utility infrastructure improvements throughout Delray Beach. Notable to this effect includes the highly anticipated North Swinton Avenue Roadway/Utility Improvement project, as well as the recently discussed Atlantic Dunes Park Parking Lot enhancement effort.

While several noted projects are the result of financial support and collaboration with the Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency and the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency, joint groundbreaking ceremonies will likewise be offered to help acknowledge and celebrate respective achievements after the successful completion of individual projects as outlined.

Considerations Regarding Northeast 7th Avenue

In response to thoughts and observations offered during the April 9th regular meeting relative to the merits of permanent closure of vehicular access for Northeast 7th Avenue, please be advised that several review activities are currently underway to help ultimately determine final design decisions accordingly.

As I've discussed with both Director of Development Services Anthea Gianniotes and Director of Public Works Missie Barletto, via a meeting on the subject yesterday morning, guidance to this effect will be determined by the outcome of the Palm Trail Neighborhood Improvement Plan, to likewise feature

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public engagement exercises as a function of the neighborhood planning process. Additionally, should it be decided that the vehicular access be permanently closed, improvements to create attractive solutions accordingly are dependent upon the completion of the Atlantic Crossing project (as a portion of the parcel currently used for construction staging remains necessary to construct a future cul-de-sac).

The Office of the City Manager and leadership of both Development Services and Public Works will likewise host a meeting with representatives of the Palm Trail Homeowners Association in the coming weeks to initiate the planning process. Meanwhile, please be aware that the thoroughfare continues to remain temporarily closed to vehicular traffic.

Revenue Forecast Modeling to Help Evaluate Millage Rate Policy Considerations

As both the Office of the City Manager and the Department of Finance are currently engaged in initial revenue and expenditure forecast models necessary to ultimately support recommendations for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Proposed Budget, please be advised that a feature involving this exercise will include a presentation of property tax collections at various millage rate scenarios to help facilitate potential considerations to set a tentative rate.

As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Chief Financial Officer Hugh Dunkley, guidance to this effect will also assist the City Commission regarding potential budgetary impacts involving each scenario noted, as well as any service level adjustments that might be realized accordingly.

A public dialogue to this effect will likewise be included during the June 11th budget workshop meeting, enabling respective direction from the City Commission prior to finalizing proposed budget recommendations to be formally offered during the July 9th session.

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Anticipated Agenda Considerations for 2024 Annual Goal Setting Session

Given the myriad of large-scale considerations that will necessitate City Commission policy expectations and guidance, this year's annual goal setting session, scheduled to take place Friday, May 3rd at the Delray Beach Municipal Golf Course Clubhouse, will offer a defined focus relative to specific direction in these regards.

The meeting agenda will therefore highlight such for the Delray Beach Municipal Golf Course, specific public engagement trajectory to support ancillary citywide parks improvement programming, as well as expectations for the Old School Square campus (and its individual and collective facilities).


