RECOMMENDED NATIVE PLANT MATERIALS

All Landscape improvements proposed to bring properties into compliance with minimum landscape standards must also conform to the requirements for the installation of native plant materials.

Fifty percent of all new trees installed must be native to South Florida and twenty-five percent of all shrubs and ground covers must be native species. While the following list of native plant material is not by any means an all inclusive list, it includes native species that can be generally found in local plant nurseries:

TREES:Trees must be a minimum of 12' in height at installation. When selecting the
type of tree, be mindful of overhead utilities and the ground space available for
mature trunk development.

STOPPERS	Eugenia spp.	15'
WAX MYRTLE	Myrica cerifera	15'

SHRUBS:

Shrubs need to be a minimum of 24" in height and 24" on center at installation.

WALTER'S VIBURNUM	Viburnum obovatum

GROUND COVERS: No minimum

No minimum height, typically spaced at 15" on center.
