RE: ANNEXATION, SMALL SCALE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT, AND REZONING FOR 13555 S. MILITARY TRAIL (7-ELEVEN AT VIA DELRAY)

Pursuant to the Land Development Regulations of the City of Delray Beach, you are hereby notified that the City Commission will consider a privately-initiated annexation request, small-scale Future Land Use Map (FLUM) amendment, and a change in zoning district for approximately 3.57± acres at **13555 S. Military Trail** located at the southwest corner of Military Trail and Via Delray Boulevard at a public hearing held on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2019 at 4:00 PM** (or as soon thereafter as may be heard) in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, 100 NW 1st Avenue, Delray Beach, Florida. The property location is indicated on the attached map.

The existing and proposed FLUM and zoning designations are as follows:


Existing Palm Beach County FLUM Designation:	Commercial High (CH-5)
Proposed City of Delray Beach FLUM Designation:	General Commercial (GC)
Existing Palm Beach County Zoning District:	General Commercial (GC)
Proposed City of Delray Beach Zoning District:	General Commercial (GC)

The property owner indicates an intention to redevelop the site with a larger convenience store, new self-service car wash, and additional fuel pumps.
