These are the species of trees that are readily available in the nursery industry and can meet the current City of Delray Beach"s standard for Trees, under LDR 4.6.16(H)(2)(d) Landscape Design Standards-Trees: "Shall be a species having an average mature spread of crown greater than 20 (20) feet and having trunks which can be maintained in a clean condition with over six (6) feet of clear mature wood. Trees species shall be a minimum of 16 (16) feet in overall height at the time of planting, with a minimum of six (6) feet of single straight trunk with eight (8) feet of clear trunk and a seven (7) foot spread of canopy."
